Marygrace Hernandez Leveille, PhD, RN, ACNP-BC



Dr Leveille is the Nurse Scientist for Baylor University Medical Center (BUMC) and also has Nursing Research responsibilities for Baylor Health Care System (BHCS). Dr Leveille received her Master’s in Nursing and PhD in Nursing from the University of Texas at Arlington. Dr Leveille’s 25 years of nursing experience has focused on Cardiology and Cardiovascular surgery and she has practiced as an Acute Care Nurse Practitioner for 14 years. Her doctoral dissertation focused on pre-menopausal Hispanic women, metabolic syndrome risks factors and coronary computed tomography angiography. Currently, Dr Leveille is assisting BUMC nurses in conducting more than 40 active research studies. In addition to responsibilities as a nurse scientist, Dr Leveille teaches Research and Evidence-Based Practice classes to BHCS nurses. Dr Leveille is active in many professional organizations and was recently inducted as the Vice President for the Southern Nursing Research Society.
