GENERAL INFORMATION

- A podium session is a 15 minute session consisting of presentations of **completed** research, **completed** clinical projects/best practices, methodology papers and/or theory development/conceptual analysis papers.
- A poster session is a visual display of completed or in-progress work. (In-progress work is only eligible for poster presentation.)
- A Workshop session consists of a 30 minute podium presentation focusing on application of research methods or new innovations in theory, education or practice.

Submission Deadline for Podium, and Poster Abstract Submissions

Materials must be received by **11:59 PM on December 1**. No extensions will be granted. Acknowledgement that materials arrived on time will be sent via email.

Submission Format:

Abstracts (350 words) should address the following criteria, based on the type of abstract submitted:

Research focused abstracts:

- Short specific Title
- Objective: Statement of the study's objective
- Background: Hypothesis, or a description of the problem
- Methods: Study design, including a description of participants, procedures, measures, and appropriate statistical analyses
- Results: Specific results in summary form
- Discussion/Conclusions: Description of the main outcome(s) and relevance to nursing

Practice/Quality Improvement Project abstracts:

- Short specific Title
- Objective: Statement of the study's objective
- Background: Description of the problem
- Methods: Project design, including a description of participants, procedures, guiding framework and/or clinical guidelines (as applicable), outcomes measures, and appropriate statistical analyses
- Results: Specific results in summary form
- Discussion/Conclusions: Description of the main outcome(s) and relevance to a specific nursing practice area

Workshop session abstracts:

- Short specific Title
- Objective: Statement of the study's objective
- Background: Description of the problem
- Summary: Describe the relevance of this topic to enhance theory application, research, education, or practice

Abstract Selection and Notification

The Program Abstract Selection Committee **reserves the right to accept abstracts as a podium or poster presentation.** The presenting author on the abstract will be notified by email on or around **February 1, 2018** if the abstract is accepted. Once notified of acceptance of either a podium or poster presentation, you will be expected to present in the format approved upon confirming your acceptance. We have limited space for posters, so if you are accepted for a podium presentation, you will not have the option of changing to a poster.

Confirmation of acceptance by primary author: required by February 15, 2018.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Presenters are required to register for the program and be responsible for their own registration, travel and related expenses.

- Podium session (if accepted):
 - Electronic file of presentation content and CE requirements including conflict of interest forms will be due March 15, 2018 for accreditation purposes.
- Poster session (if accepted):
 - Your poster must stand unsupported on a table which will be supplied and is no more than 36” x 48” in a trifold shape.
 - You will be expected to display the poster and be present throughout the designated viewing times.
