JBI Evidence Implementation Training Program 2023-2024

This six-month program is designed for nurse clinicians, nurse leaders, and clinical researchers who want to explore strategies that promote evidence implementation and policy and practice change. The program consists of two week-long intensive workshops that will be conducted virtually by the LSU JBI Centre. In the intervening months between the workshops, participants will work with a Clinical Coach to create and launch an Evidence Implementation Project at their home institution. Participants must have access to a clinical population for their implementation projects. By the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- 1. Describe and apply critical elements of evidence implementation and project management.
- 2. Develop and hone leadership skills necessary to implement and sustain a successful evidence implementation project.
- 3. Develop and sharpen analytical thinking and writing skills that can improve patient, family, and system outcomes.

Week 1: August 21-25, 2023 (31.25 contact hours) **Week 2:** February 19-23, 2024 (33.75 contact hours)

Nursing Continuing Professional Development Credit: Participants will earn a total of 65.0 contact hours of nursing continuing professional development credit based on attendance.
