Faculty Needs to Increase Enrollment by 30 students

Fall 2007	4.0 FTE	\$361,200 to \$412,800 (4 Instructors @ \$70,000 or 4 Asst. Professors @ \$80,000 including 29% fringe)
Spring 2008	10.0 FTE	\$903,000 to \$1,032,000 (10 Instructors @ \$70,000 or 10 Asst. Professors @ \$80,000 including 29% fringe)
Fall 2008	12 FTE	\$1,083,600 to \$1,238,400 (12 Instructors @ \$70,000 or 12 Asst. Professors @ \$80,000 including 29% fringe)

Resources Needed to Increase Enrollment

- Qualified Faculty
- Clinical facilities to accommodate student clinical learning experiences
- Office space for increase in faculty numbers
- Increase in classroom space to accommodate classes of 100+ students
- Clinical laboratory space to accommodate undergraduate classes of 100+ students

Resources Needed to Increase Enrollment

- Infrastructure to support increased students and faculty
 - Computers
 - Clerical assistance
 - Student affairs personnel
- Increase faculty support to basic science departments
