### Confidentiality Statement

The Louisiana State University Health Science Center New Orleans School of Nursing (LSUHSC-NO SON) Nursing Skills and Technology Center (NSTC) supports the Code of Student Conduct. The Code of Student Conduct is applicable to all members of the SON community.

Students are expected to maintain strict confidentiality surrounding events in the NSTC. This includes patient history information obtained prior to the activity, as well as information obtained and discussed during prebriefing, the activity, and debriefing.

The NSTC has audiovisual recording capabilities. These recordings will be available on the server for 30 days after a simulation.
