SANE-A or SANE-P **IAFN CERTIFICATION**

Steps for SANE Certification

1. Completion of a **40** Hour IAFN Didactic course in SANE-A (Adolescent / Adult population) or SANE-P (Pediatric Population)
2. Completion of an Approved SANE Preceptorship.
3. Completion, or a minimum of **300** Practice hours within three years from Didactic and Skills Lab (**200** hours must be within the pediatric or Adult / Adolescent population you intend to certify in).
4. **IAFN** SANE Certification Examination is offered only **twice** each year. Exams are hosted in **APRIL** and **SEPTEMBER**.

Whether newly trained or currently practicing as a SANE Nurse, and meet steps 1-3, you can receive support to complete the ***International Association of Forensic Nurses*** certification exam through the ***LSU Health New Orleans SANE Program***.

1. ***Study Materials*** provided.
2. ***Cost of Online IAFN*** review Course 8 weeks prior to exam date.
3. ***Cost of Live Review*** through ***AFN***.
4. ***Cost of Certification Exam*** for your chosen population SANE-A or SANE-P
