The goal of the Infection Prevention program is to identify and reduce risks of acquiring and transmitting infections among patients, staff, physicians, students, volunteers, contract service workers and visitors. Infection Prevention is the responsibility of everyone who cares for our patients. Each individual is responsible for being knowledgeable of and responsible for carrying out the policies and procedures that address Infection Prevention activities.
