## HIPAA – Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act

- HIPAA protects the privacy and confidentiality of patients, employees and the public at large.
- This law requires that any covered entity that transmits electronic health information must have a designated Privacy Official.

## Privacy Officer – Sandra Smith, Extension 8-4481

- The Privacy Officer audits units, employees with chart access and physicians.
- Audits are conducted monthly. A questionable breach will be reported to the Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Steven E. Farrell.

## **Privacy Reminders**

- Do not access a patient's chart unless you have a VALID REASON.
- You cannot access YOUR OWN MEDICAL RECORD.
- When on the unit, close charts when you are finished with them. Do not leave charts open were anyone can read them.
- Always sign off from the computer before leaving the area.
- Please do not give your ID and password to ANYONE, whether nurse, office manager, etc. <u>YOU</u> will be held accountable for any breach.
