Huddle Helper Student/Faculty Protection Plan

Purpose: To inform students/faculty on what is required for clinical rotations at Ochsner Health.

Guidelines to keep students, patients, visitors and employees safe:

- **Masks**: Effective July 26, all students/faculty regardless of location, assignment or vaccination status must be fully masked at all times while indoors at an Ochsner facility.
- **Exposure**: Students/Faculty with positive or suspected COVID-19 must be cleared prior to return to Ochsner by their school health office using the most up-to-date CDC guidelines.

Vaccinated Students/Faculty

- Proof of Full Vaccination : Schools will provide one email per program to studentservices@lgh.org containing:

 Completed Student Vaccination Chart (provided by Ochsner Lafayette General Student services
 Proof of students' full vaccination status
- Identification: Green badge sleeves will be made available to aid in identifying
 vaccinated students and faculty. While wearing this identification, vaccinated students/
 faculty are able to use surgical masks. If students/faculty are in a direct patient care role,
 infection prevention precautions should still be utilized as needed.

Unvaccinated Students/Faculty

- **Masks**: Beginning with the first clinical day, students/faculty without valid submitted proof of vaccination will be required to wear a KN95 mask at all times, regardless of location or assignment, while at an Ochsner Lafayette General facility.
- COVID-19 Testing: All unvaccinated students/faculty will be required to be weekly COVID-19 tested. This is strictly a screening process. This is not a patient testing process. If follow up care is needed because of a positive result, the student/faculty can/should see a provider of their choosing. We are currently working through the weekly COVID-19 testing processes and will share details in future communications. Additional information will be forthcoming on implementation date.
- Exemptions: Any person with an approved exemption will adhere to the unvaccinated procedures.
